II. Tyre Regulations



- Sprint-Races GTC:
 - 2 sets of slicks for Q1, Q2, Race 1 and Race 2
 (1 set consists of 2 front axle tyres and 2 rear axle tyres)
- Goodyear 60:
 - 1 set of slicks for Qualifying Goodyear 60 and Race Goodyear 60 (1 set consists of 2 front axle tyres and 2 rear axle tyres)
- There is no limitation in the use of wet tyres.
- The tyres will be marked by Goodyear. Only these tyres are allowed to be used at this event für the correct session. It will be differenced by GTC and Goodyear 60.
- Please mark all your rims with the starting number to avoid any confusion.
- At outside temperatures below 5°C we will not send any ordered tyres via transport service providers .

Please remove all balance weights, pick up within the rims and valves before bringing the tyres to our service.



- low tyre deg





V. Tyre Handling



You should avoid immediate cooling the tyres, except when you do not need the tyres anymore. (e.g. washing hot tyres with cold water).

You should set the cold pressures at the same time for one set at the same tyre temperature.

If the hot target is reached when the tyres are within the working window you do not need to fill in air when the tyres cooled down.

Due to no use of blankets you should scrub new tyres 1 to 2 laps slowly with avoiding curbs for this time being.

If the car returns to the pits within free practice and the target pressure needs to be adjusted you should do that directly when the car arrives and the tyres are hot.

The tyres should be stored within the shade (storage within the sun only when cold pressures are adjusted correctly).

While taking tyre temperatures and pressures you always need to pay attention to do it in the same order.

Are to be used Valve caps.
